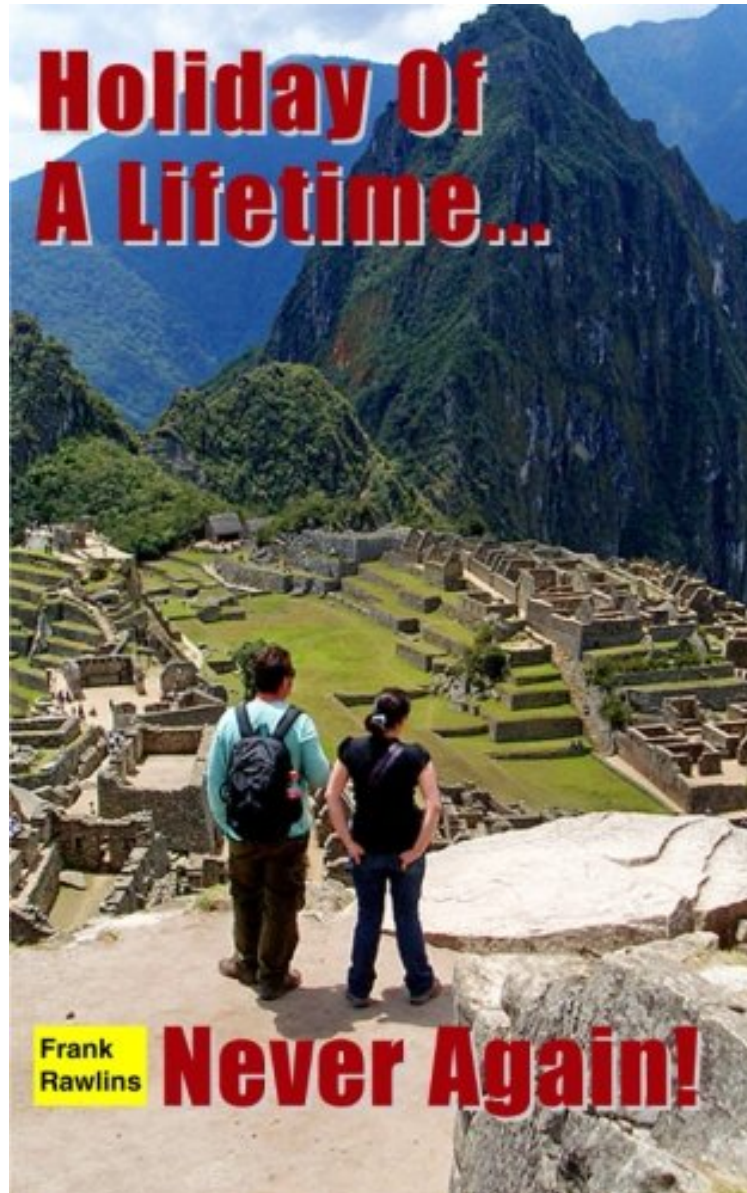

They certainly hadn't reckoned on the merciless Bicester Bug.
