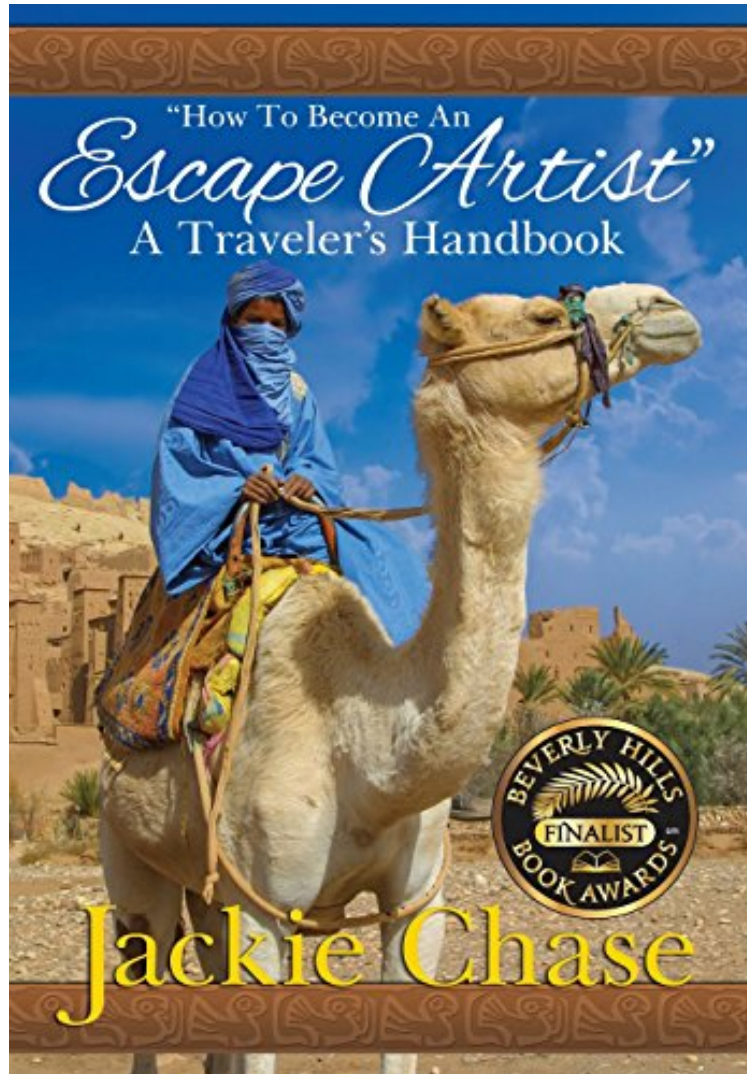

However, if you are the type of traveler who likes to get off the beaten path you can learn a trick or two from Ms. Chase who has been to over 100 countries.
