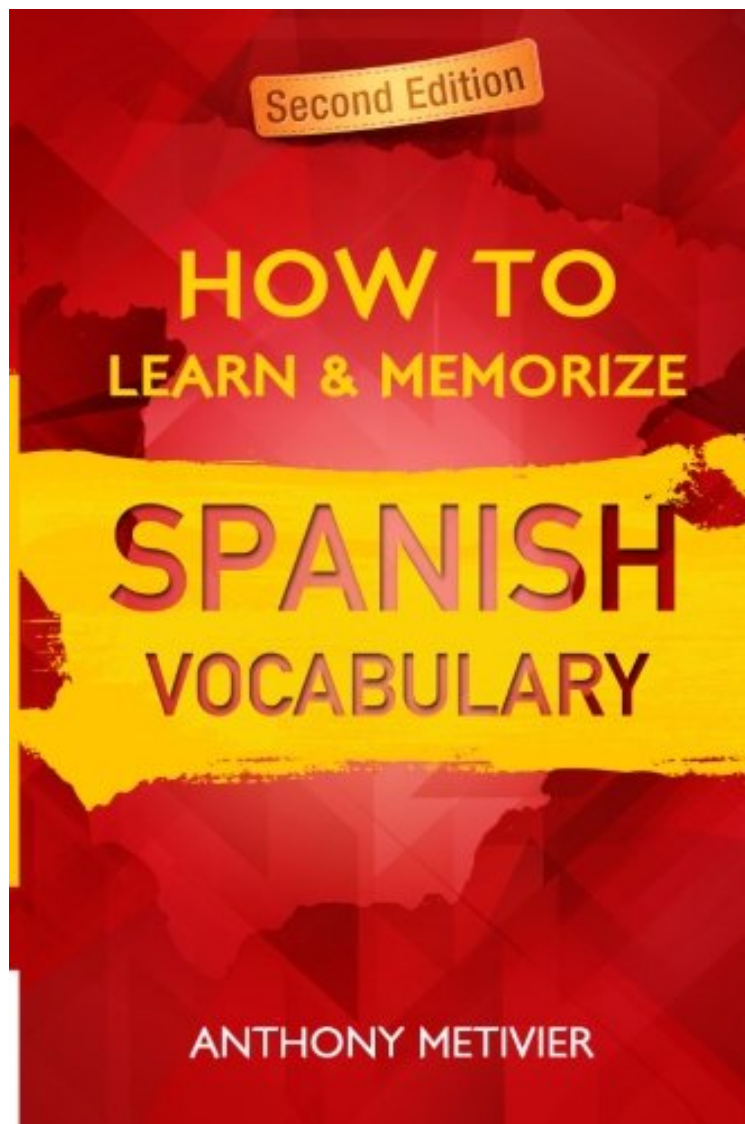

After university I gave up on them. Fast forward 20 years and I found this book by Anthony Metivier and his intelligent use of memory palaces. This is the missing link that has made all the difference! While I knew about memory palaces, their value was never made clear to me until I read this book. Memory palaces make memorising SO much easier with longer lasting results. Recently I started doing Sean Schniederjan's Minimalist Muscle Activation techniques. It comprises about 120 different exercises to wake up individual muscles and each contraction takes about 5-10 seconds. I made a memory palace and now I can do all the exercises from memory without missing any. This definitely adds to my willingness to do the exercises. I bought this book because I was considering learning Spanish. Even though I decided against learning Spanish, I still got a lot from this book. In fact I would say it was life-changing.

By Ken C. This is my first purchase of a book by Anthony Metivier, and the author really delivers more than expected. In addition to Spanish-specific learning techniques, he presents a powerful memory-building technique that I plan to use often. Building vocabulary and fluency with methods that are better than repetition-based rote exercises is the focus here, and the presentation is clear, personal, and actionable. Three things I liked best were: 1. Explanation of the principles behind the memory methods presented. This was the first section of the book. 2. Concrete examples of how to build the memory structures where our minds 'put' vocabulary as it's learned. 3. The links to extra videos and resources were surprising and impressive. This work has value beyond its pages. Cons: 1. Someone wanting just a list of Spanish words to memorize should look elsewhere. As mentioned, this work is full of concepts from a memory teaching professional, made for someone who wants to build true mastery of the language. Could be a negative for some.
