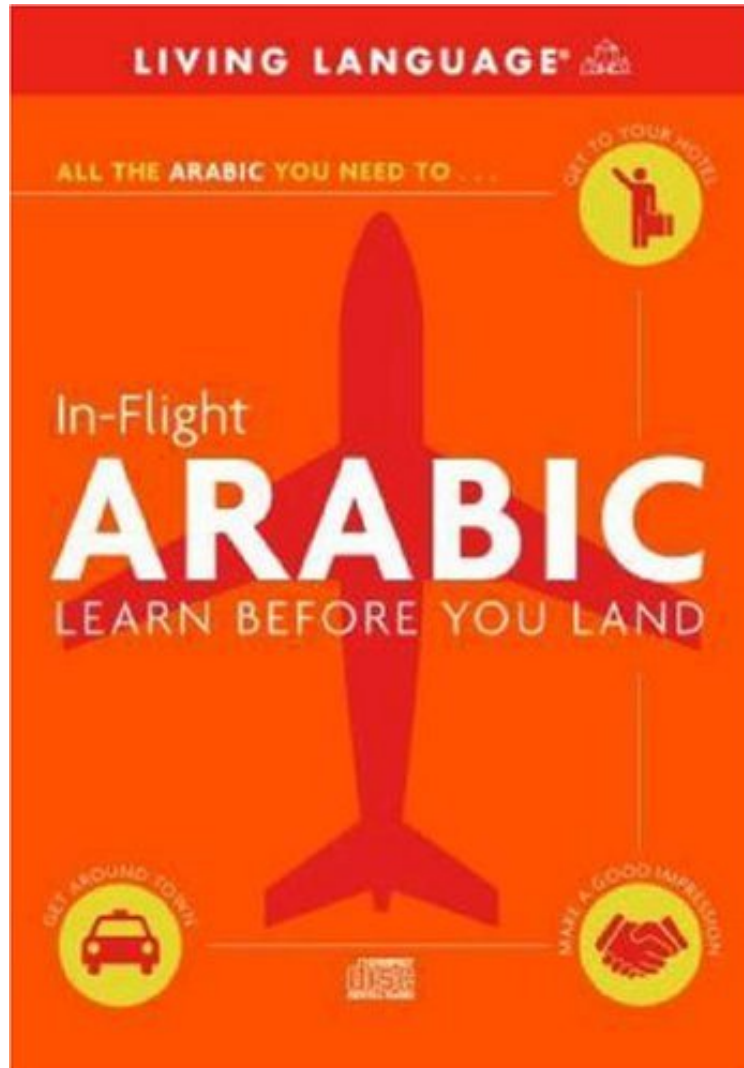

Of all of the CD/books on Arabic that I have, this really has to be the BEST!! It beats all of the others I have with pronunciation in particular is

laid out in a very logical intuitive way. My copy of the CD also came with a very useful 19 page pamphlet "Boarding Pass" (11x16cm) that summarised everything on the CD for quick easy referral. Small enough to keep in your back pocket or passport. A definite must to carry around when you're down the local Medina or Sook. It's so easy use. Rip it onto your MP3 player and start learning the important basics straight away. By the time you've flown to Egypt for example (about 5 hours) you'll have covered all of the basics you'll need to get by at your hotel the airport. It went WAY too fast, and for someone who's heard even a little Arabic (my husband is Syrian), most of this was unintelligible for me. For example, the way it taught numbers was "1, 2, 3" and said it all together, so I had no idea where one word started and the next one ended!
