Verger was a great traveler who visited much of the developing world as these countries were beginning to enter into the modern age. Following the Second World War, Verger moved to South America. In 1946, he travelled to Peru and took the photographs that are featured in this book. "Indians of Peru" is a compelling book because Pierre Verger combines the talent of a fine art photographer with the eye of an experienced ethnographer. In my mind, Pierre Verger is one the most unheralded photographers of the mid-century period. "Indians of Peru" can still be purchased at a reasonable price and I think that one day his work will be much more appreciated. Recommended.

"Indians of Peru" is an album of the descendant of the Inca in many phases of his daily life with a section devoted to the ancient ruins. In selecting these eighty-seven photographs from amongst hundreds, the editors have sought to document pictorially a colorful people and to present Pierre Verger at his most distinguished as artist and as technician. A map of Peru follows the photographs which are grouped regionally. Introduction and captions have been written in Spanish by Dr. Luis E Valcarcel, director of the National Museum of History, Lima.The English translation
