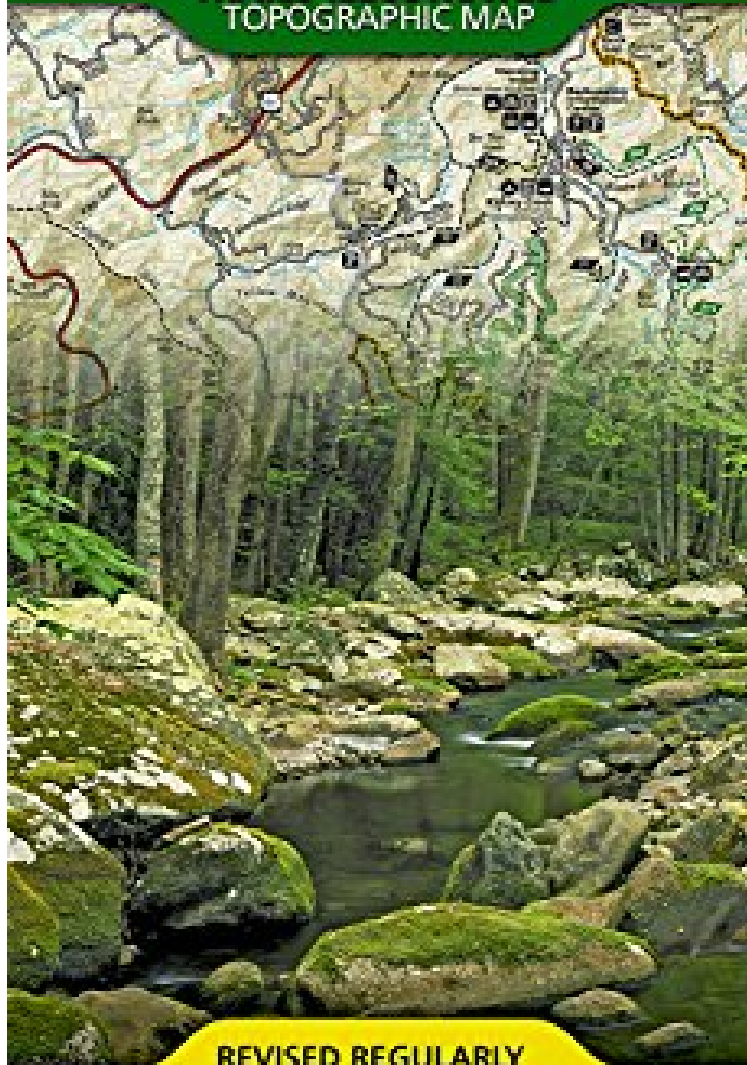

Among the recreation features clearly marked on the map are river and whitewater access points, swimming areas, waterfalls, fishing areas, overlooks, lookout towers, and campgrounds. Scenic byways are also clearly marked, for those who wish to explore the area by car.  
Every Trails Illustrated map is printed on "Backcountry Tough" waterproof, tear-resistant paper. A full UTM grid is printed on the map to aid with GPS navigation.
