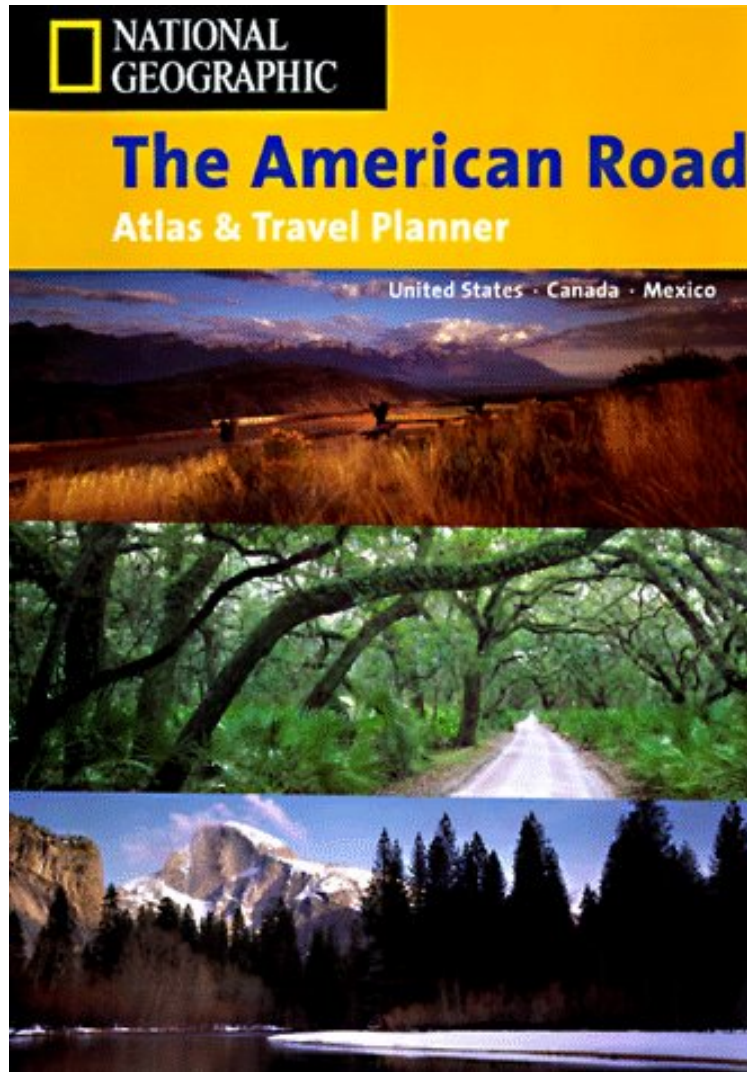

I can't understand why NG quit producing this atlas...That's a bargain for sure.It's a very study volume. Mine has started to pull away from the binding a bit, but that's to be expected when I throw it around the car all the time. The plastic-like cover is spill-resistant and extremely durable. No pages have ripped or become unbound. I am very rough on it, and I'm impressed that it's survived as well as it has.The maps are readable and accurate. There's not much more exciting than that to say about a road map. They cover all of North America, though Mexico receives no detailed coverage, nor does northern Canada (where there are few roads anyway).Aside from the maps, the atlas includes descriptions of every region of North America (Mexico is treated as one region, and Canada as two). These are really interesting, and they get the wanderlust flowing. There are also descriptions and pictures of all the major US national parks, a handy mileage chart that includes lots of cities, city/population indexes organized by state, and a comprehensive and balanced list of scenic drives around the country.

The American Road is no ordinary road atlas and no ordinary guide book. It provides everything needed to plan memorable trips, plus all the help drivers want along the road. Regional Guides, Scenic Drives, and National Park Profiles offer so many ideas and choices for planning things to see and do. All these features are clearly cross referenced to the most readable, reliable road maps available today. Handsome enough for the coffee table, it's perfect for at-home planning.
