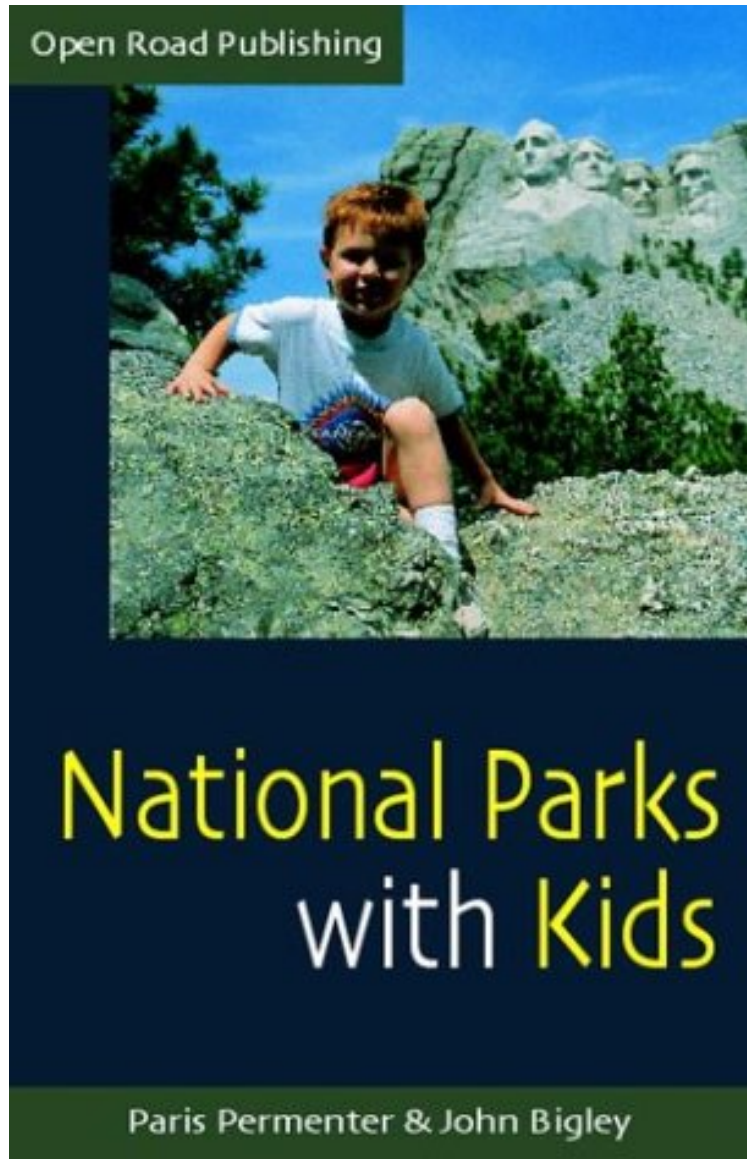

What is included in this book are an introductory section on what is available for kids in most national parks on a nation wide basis, and individual chapters on each park with lots of non-kid generic information with, at best, a paragraph vaguely related to kid stuff.

National Parks With Kids is the only guidebook available that offers a total family focus to our extensive park system. Alaska and Hawaii, and the US Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico are covered. Parks range from perennial favorites like Yellowstone, Grand Canyon, Great Smoky Mountains, Grand Tetons, Glacier, and Yosemite to lesser known treasures such as Dinosaur National Monument, Dry Tortugas National Park, and Mammoth Cave National Park. National seashores such as Padre Island, Assateague, Fire Island, and Cape Hatteras provide fun in the sun, while other destinations such as Lyndon B. Johnson National Historic Park in Texas, Martin Luther King National Historic Site, Gettysburg National Military Park, and Statue of Liberty National Monument offer educational fun for young travelers. Special chapters feaure holidays and special park festivals, indices by interest and activity, and a bibliography of reading material to introduce young travelers to the parks.
