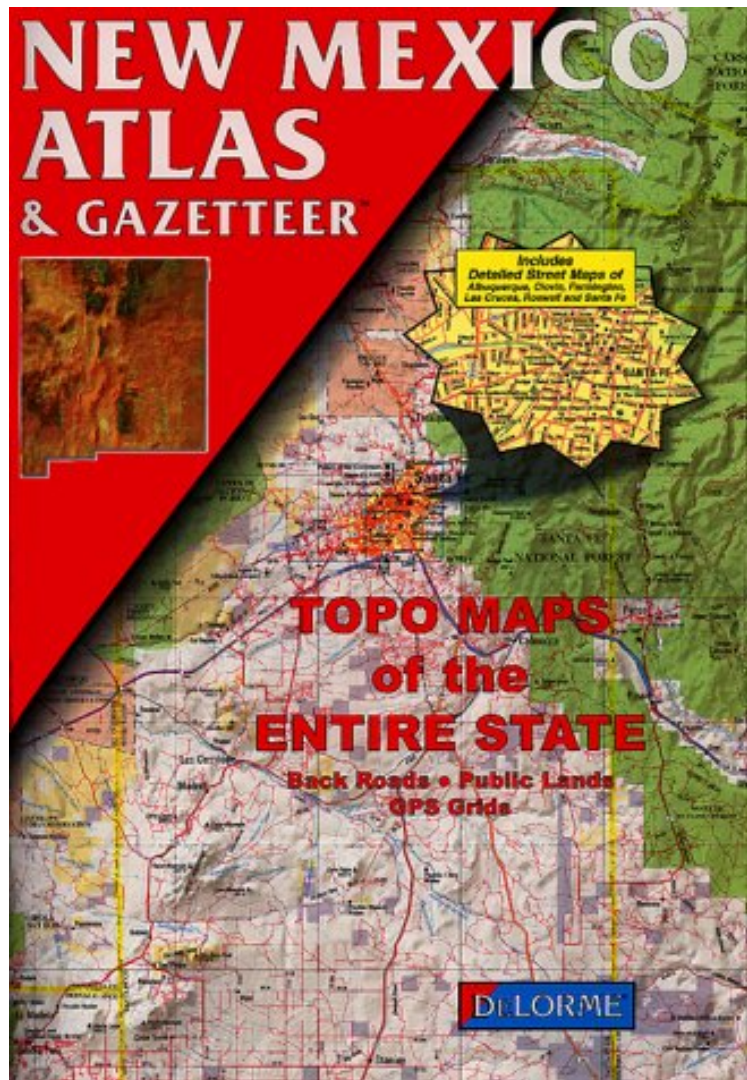

I've visited all of the 48 contiguous states. Because I like to get off the beaten track and see what a state is really like, I generally purchase a Delorme atlas and gazetteer before I go to a particular state, which is why I made sure I procured a New Mexico gazetteer. Now, using a roadmap is fine if all you want is to stay on the major highways. In fact, it's preferable to a Delorme gazetteer because it's more compact. But it's a lot more fun to get on the backroads, which aren't shown on a state map or a road atlas. And that's where the gazetteer becomes most useful. And in many cases essential, seeing that in a state like New Mexico you might not encounter another human being for miles and miles. The gazetteer shows the backroads, as well as many natural features. And because it's a topographical map, it's possible to determine in advance what sort of terrain you'll be encountering.
