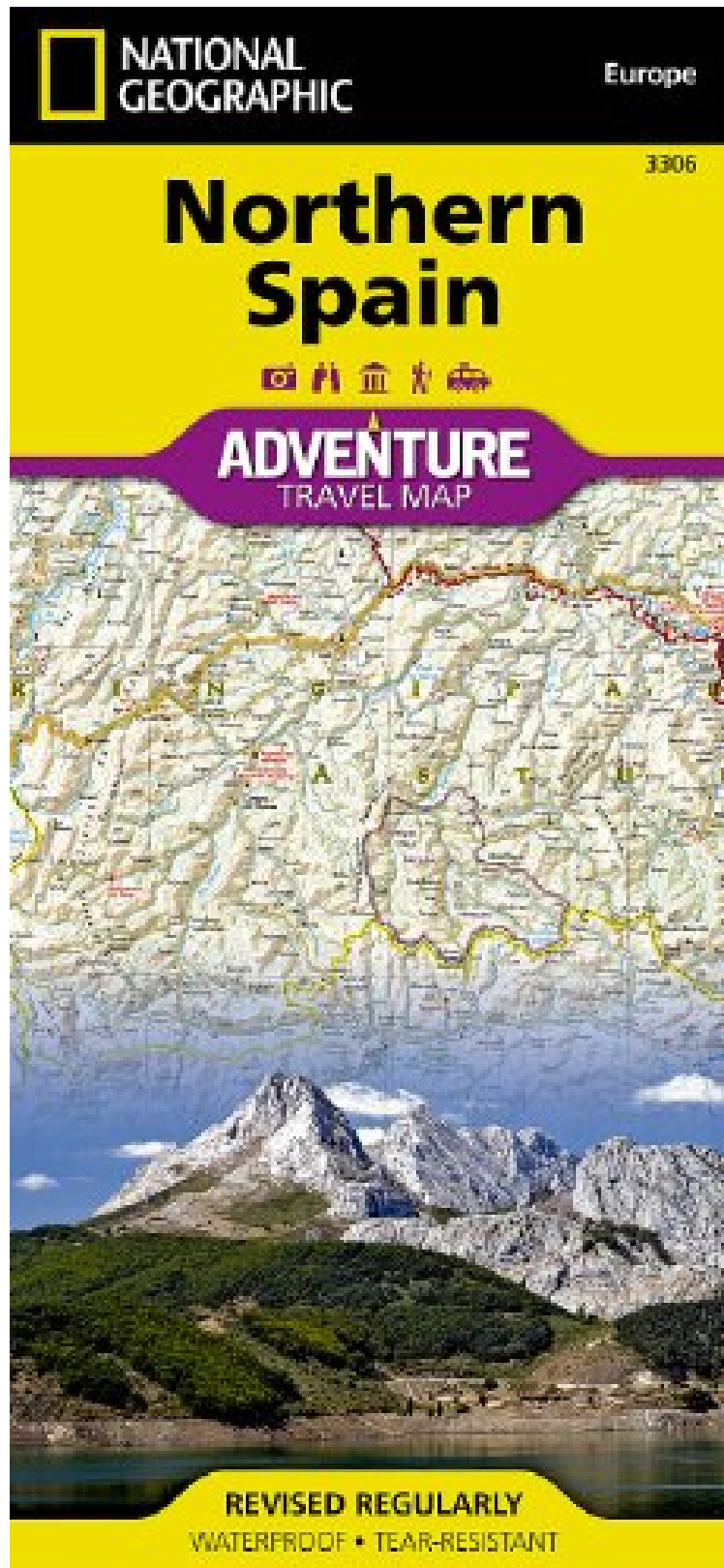

I bought the Pyrenees map to get that small portion of the trail only to find that the two maps are in a different scale, plus the Camino is not marked on the second map. If you don't care about the Camino de Santiago my complaints will not affect you in the least. It is hard to understand how NatGeo got this little detail wrong as the rest of the map really is good.

Santiago de Compostela, the capital of Galicia and the third holiest city in Christendom, is a beautifully preserved medieval cathedral town. The Basque Autonomous Community another ethnically unique region of Northern Spain boasts seaside resorts, spectacular mountain vistas, medieval cathedrals, and extraordinary 20th century architecture.
