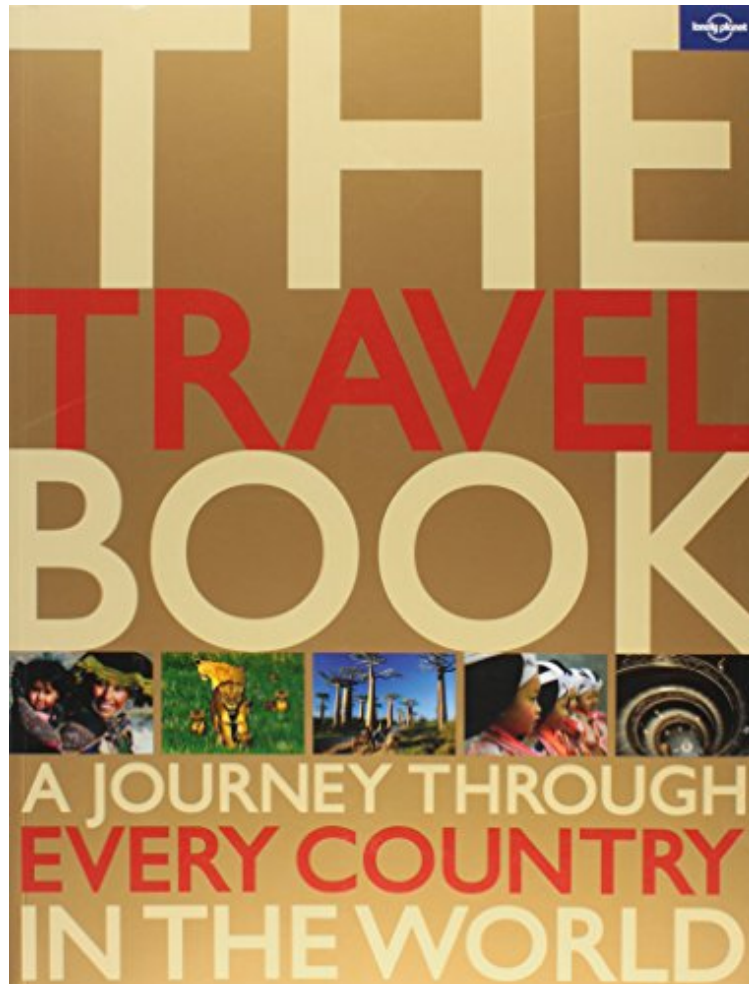

By Stephaniethis is a great book! it is more of a "coffee table" book to flip through rather than something that you would use for planning a trip. if you are planning a trip around the world (like me) it IS good to get a quick snapshot of different countries that you may not have considered visiting before. each spread (two pages with the book lying flat) represents one country and has a picture on one page and the other page has a list of basic info- coolest place to visit in that particular country, what food/ drinks to try, interesting tidbits, etc. I like the quick overview of each country but I wish that the pictures were more noteworthy- sometimes they are just of a group of local residents or something and I feel like it would be better if the picture represented the most noteworthy thing about the country to give an idea of the thing that most tourists would probably want to go see if they were visiting. there are some things I would improve about it but overall I think it is a great book and I've enjoyed having it.
