But because Jerusalem is the cradle of Western civilization, the repository of the sources from which all monotheistic religion sprang, it is probably the hardest place to actually understand for visitors who come to look at old stones and mystical symbols. This book explains all that. The ruins of the Second Temple and the magnetism of its Western Wall is the foundation of Judaism and the origin of monotheism. You will undertand it with this book. The jumble of form and style that is the Church of the Holy Sepulchre becomes a trail of more than 30 iconographic stops that supply the basis of Christian theology. The sublime architectural marvel that is the Dome of the Rock becomes the hiding place who's secret geometry unveils an understanding of Islamic belief.
