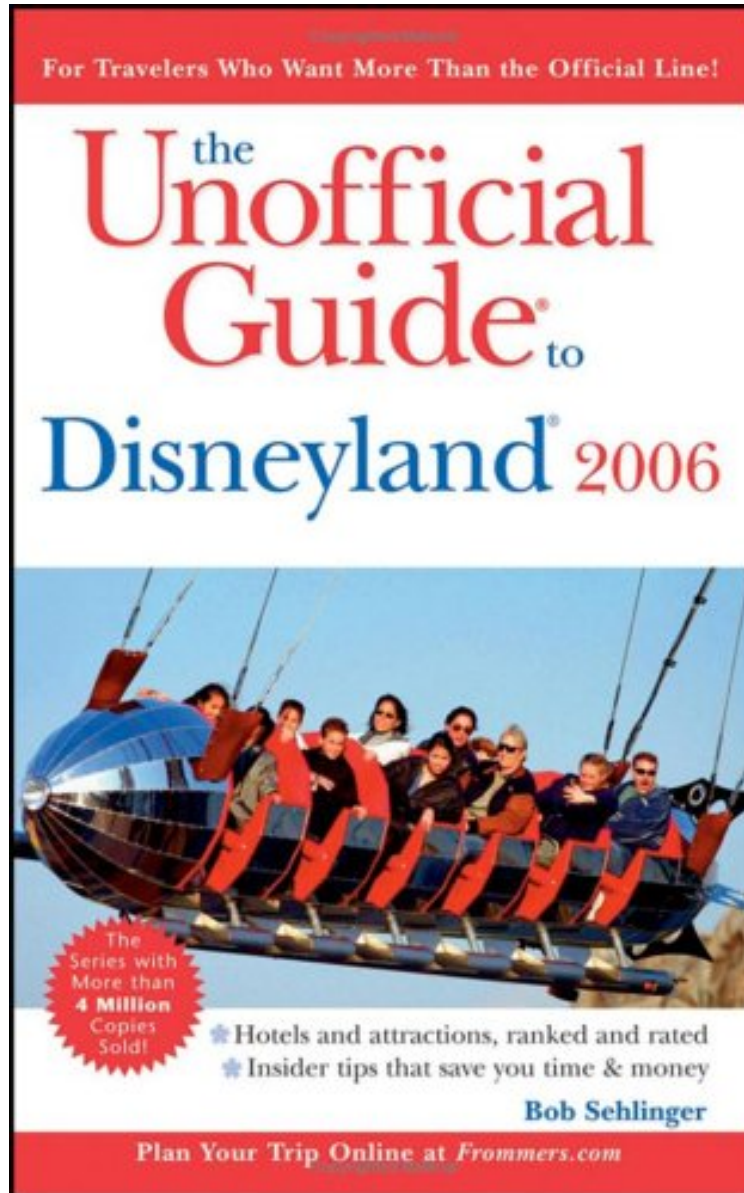

Actually, you should not go to Disneyland either. The team that wrote this book have created another masterpiece. This book is full of practical advice, not just attraction reviews. Some might think the Touring Plans are too anal, but you have to be anal to make Disneyland or Disney World work at any time other than the emptiest parts of the year. You can wake up a little early and hit your entire days worth of attractions by noon, or you can slack it and not see an days worth of attractions in two days. They also understand the psychology of travelling with a family and have just a few incredibly valuable tips on important things to remember. My favorites (paraphrased): When you get back from your trip, there is a pretty good chance all your pre-school kids will talk about or remember is the pool at the hotel. So DONT STRESS every detail.
