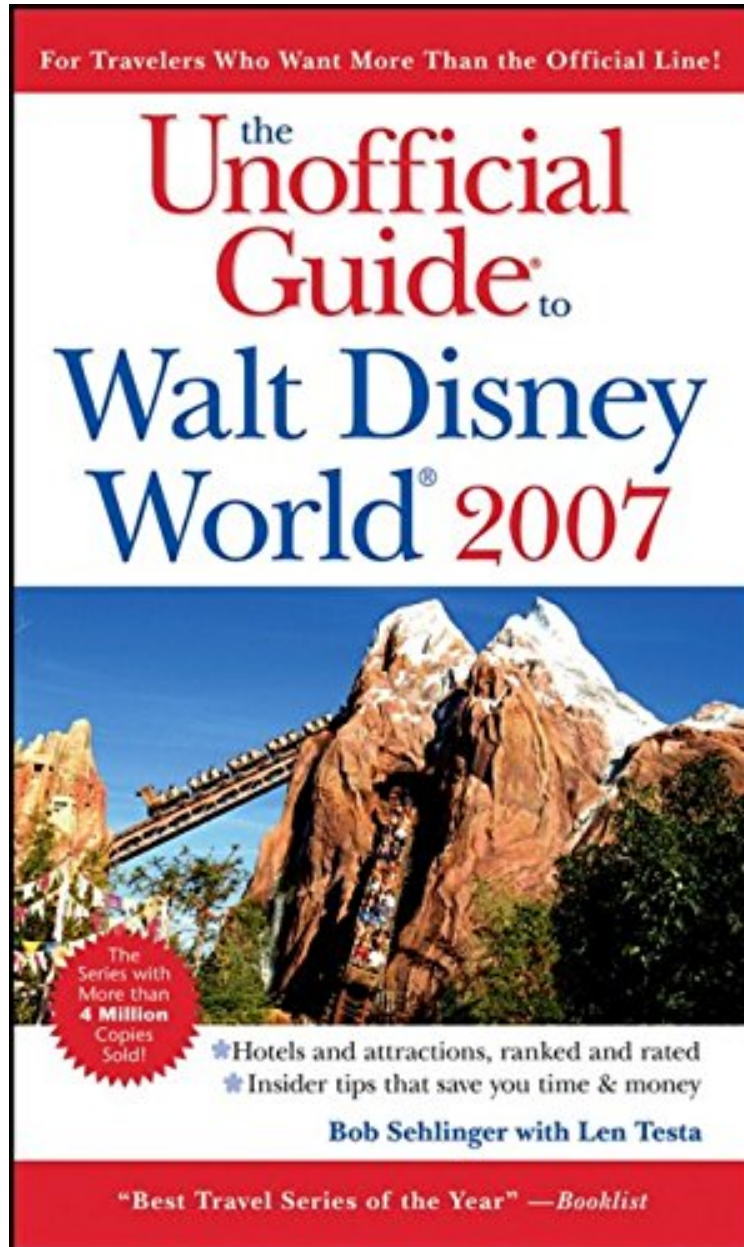

Unlike the Official Guide (which I've also reviewed) this is an unbiased, occasionally snarky, honest guide. All the restaurants and hotels on property, and some off-property, are thoroughly reviewed, including age appropriateness and comparison charts. Warning - the print is fine, and this is a huge book. Read it at home before you go, so that you have the info in your head to begin with. They include both full-day and part day touring plans for each park. Plans for people with kids and without. Plans for people who sacrifice all their fun for their toddler's fun. And, they have cut-out pocket summaries in the back of the book so that you aren't carrying the VERY heavy main book with you to the parks. Funny, and, as mentioned before, sometimes sarcastic and sometimes critical, this is not a dry, no opinion book. If that's not your style, don't buy it. We consulted it many times each day and tried several of the recommended restaurants. We all completely agreed with the ratings they received. Their advice on park attractions was absolutely flawless. The only caution - we were quite disappointed in the Dixie Landings "moderate" resort and wished there had been a more frank assessment of housekeeping and the condition of the rooms, which has slipped tremendously since our last visit. Better advice is to dip into the college fund and stay in a top tier resort. They were correct in stating that the French Quarter was nicer than Riverside as it has recently been renovated, but they failed to mention that their housekeeping is so poor. Some employees were obviously disgruntled and bashed Disney openly. It's sad to see what has happened to the "happiest place on earth." That aside, we all had a wonderful time, thanks in part to this book. This is the only book needed to get the most out of the parks, but it is advisable to study up the day before and remember to tear out the handy summary page provided at the back of the book to keep in your pocket while at the park.
